The State of Colorado honors Italian-American Heritage



WHEREAS, of all the immigrant groups who came to the United States during the Ellis Island era, few made a more significant numerical impact than the Italians, many of whom settled in Colorado; and

WHEREAS, Italians were instrumental in establishing Colorado as a leader in railroad transportation, the mining, timber and masonry industries, and agricultural production and distribution; and

WHEREAS, Italians have contributed to Colorado's growth and economy throughout its history by the establishment of small and large businesses; and

WHEREAS, Italians have left an indelible imprint on the art, culture and culinary desires of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, Italians have been instrumental in improving the quality of life in Colorado by serving in public office and through their philanthropic and benevolent endeavors; and

WHEREAS, Italians continue to enhance and promote the diversity of Colorado by fostering their cultural heritage which is supported by the numerous active ItalianAmerican organizations throughout the state;

Mother Cabrini Day



Gov. Jared Polis signed a bill in March making the first Monday in October Cabrini Day, the result of three decades of attempts to repeal Columbus Day. Cabrini Day is the first paid state holiday in honor of a woman in the United States.

Mother Cabrini was born Maria Francesca Cabrini on July 15, 1850, in Sant'Angelo Lodigiano, in the Lombard Province of Lodi (Italy). She was the first U.S. citizen to be canonized and is the patron saint of immigrants.
